What is SIPOC (Suppliers, Inputs, Process, Outputs, Customers) Template?

SIPOC (Suppliers, Inputs, Process, Outputs, Customers) template is a popular tool used in business process mapping and quality management to identify and analyze the key elements of a process. - Describe the specific steps involved in the process.
- Identify any subprocesses or tasks that are part of the larger process.

O - Outputs: What are the products, services, or results produced by the process?

- Define what your organization produces as a result of the process.
- Consider both tangible (e.g., physical goods) and intangible (e.g., reports, data) outputs.

C - Customers: Who receives the outputs of the process?

- Identify all the customers or stakeholders who receive the products or services produced by the process.
- Consider both internal (e.g., other departments within your company) and external customers (e.g., clients, patients).

The SIPOC template is often used in various industries, such as:

1. Quality management: to identify areas for improvement and optimize processes.
2. Supply chain management: to map relationships with suppliers and customers.
3. Business process re-engineering: to analyze and redesign processes.
4. Operational excellence: to streamline workflows and eliminate inefficiencies.
